





- Kids will perform and make music together online, in studio, at recitals and for the public
- Students will build their skills with mentorship, leadership and volunteer opportunities
- We will expand our Recording Arts, Song to Studio and Sound Engineering programs
- We will resume our music programs at Turning Point Youth Services and at Kapapmahchakwew-Wandering Spirit School
- We are exploring an opportunity for a new, permanent music school in Jane Finch. We look forward to sharing exciting details of this project in the new year!

We see this year and the years ahead as a chance to embrace all the great things that virtual learning has revealed to us—breaking down musical, physical and geographic boundaries and increasing accessibility to all we have on offer, to make sure RPSM students have the necessary tools to thrive, even in these challenging times.
